"DEBT CONVERSION AGREEMENT ACT 1931 (No. 2)."

DATE OF COMING INTO FORCE.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria, passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of His present Majesty, King George V., intituled the Delt Conversion Agreement Act 1931 (No. 2), it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette, and whereas it is further provided that the Governor in Council may not make such proclamation unless he is satisfied that the Parliament of the Commonwealth and the Parliament of each of the States of New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, and Tasmania have respectively passed an Act approving of the Agreement, a copy of which is set out in the Schedule to the said Debt Conversion Agreement Act 1931 (No. 2); Now THEREFORE I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, being satisfied that the Parliament of the Commonwealth and the Parliament of each of the States of New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, and Tasmania have respectively passed an Act approving the said Agreement, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the twelfth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, as the day upon which the said Debt Conversion Agreement Act 1931 (No. 2) shall come into force in the State of Victoria.

Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twelfth day of January, in the year of our Loid One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, and in the twenty-second year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
