## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c.,

THE Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the fourteenth day of June, 1932, as the time for the commencement and holding of the First Session of the Thirty-first Parliament of Victoria, for the despatch of business, at the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, in the Parliament Houses, situate in Spring-street, in the City of Melbourne: And the Honorable the Members of the Legislative Council and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-fourth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, and in the twenty-third year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
