Factories and Shops Acts 1928 (No. 3677).

-DETERMINATION OF THE WIREWORKERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 1st June, 1932, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), and the Order in Council thereunder, such portions of the City of Sandringham as are not included within the said Metropolitan District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warmambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room in the process, trade, or business of—

A wire-worker, using six gauge or smaller wire, but not including persons employed in making wire netting, barbed wire, wire nails, or wire mattresses,"

has made the following Determination, viz. :--

(1) That on the 1st day of June, 1932, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

(2) Apprentices or Improvers.	Juvenile Workers, i.s., persons under 21 years of age (other than apprentices and improvers), engaged minding switts, blacking, painting, or oiling, earrying or moving material, packing, cleaning up factory, or going messages.	Other Employees.

(4) OVERTIME:-

For work done between 1 p.m. and midnight on the day on which the half-holiday is usually observed For work done between 5.30 p.m. and midnight on the other working days

For work done between midnight and 7.45 a.m.

Double time.

(5) Special Rates.—Double time shall be the rate for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Australia Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), Christmas Day, or Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on (6) Parment for Holldays.—Ordinary rates shall be paid for the following holidays if not worked:—Good Friday, Eight Hours Day, and Christmas Day.

(7) Allowanges.—Any employee engaged on work away from the workshop shall be—

(a) conveyed to and from work free, or allowed the fares necessarily expended in going to and fro;

(b) paid the ordinary rate of wages for time occupied in travelling.

(8) Piece-work.—The lowest piece-work prices for wholly manufacturing articles specified in the following Schedule shall be the prices set forth in such Schedule. (Note.—Any person employed on work not mentioned in the Schedule must be paid the wages rate for such work.)
