Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677).

DETERMINATION OF THE BRICKLAYERS BOARD.

NOTE .- (1) This Determination on the 17th June, 1932, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

(2) On the 7th July, 1926, the power to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed laying or fixing faience or majolica on floors, walls, or ceilings, was taken from the Tilelayers Board and conferred exclusively on the Bricklayers Board.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons (other than labourers) wheresoever employed in the process, trade, or business of a bricklayer" has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 17th June, 1932, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
