Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677).

## DETERMINATION OF THE SLATERS AND TILERS BOARD.

NOTE .- This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

I N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons wheresoever employed in the process, trade, or business of a slater, roof-tiler, ridger, shingler, or cement tiler (other than a tiler laying veraudah or flooring tiles)" has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 24th February, 1933, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

(3) TIME OF BEGINNING AND ENDING WORK-

8 a.m. .. 5 p.m. on five days in the week.

8 a.m. .. 12 noon on the other working day of the week on which the half-holiday is locally observed.

- (4) OVERTIME.—All work done outside the hours specified as the times of beginning and ending work, or for any work done within such hours in excess of 44 hours in any week, shall be paid for at the rate of time and a half.
- (5) Special Rates Double time shall be the rate for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Australia Day (26th January), Good Friday. Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

(7) Definition.—Slater's or tilor's measurement is the net square measurement of the roof with i square foot extra for every lineal foot of eaves, hips, valleys, gutters, and gables.
