Milk Board Act 1933 (No. 4183)

DETERMINATION OF MILK PRICES.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twentyseventh day of April, 1934.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria.

Mr. Pennington Mr. Goudie

Colonel Cohen.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the Milk Board Act 1933, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby approve the following determination of milk prices by the Milk Board:—

DETERMINATION.

- 1. The minimum prices which shall be paid to owners of dairy farms for milk for sale or distribution in the metropolis shall be as follow:—
 - (a) For milk forwarded by rail by the owner of any dairy farm for delivery to any dairyman in the metropolis or to any dairyman outside the metropolis who sells or distributes milk in the metropolis—11d. per gallon ex rail.
 - (b) For milk forwarded by road by the owner of any dairy farm for delivery to any dairyman in the metro-polis or to any dairyman outside the metropolis who sells or distributes milk in the metropolis—11d. per gallon at dairyman's premises.
 - gallon at dairyman's premises.

 (o) For milk delivered by the owner of any dairy farm to any factory or milk depot from which milk is forwarded directly or indirectly to any dairyman who sells or distributes milk in the metropolis—10d. per gallon at factory or milk depot.

 Provided that the owner of any such factory or milk depot may deduct from the determined price such amount as is actually incurred by him in respect of freight by rail or road from the factory or milk depot to the metropolis.

2. This determination shall take effect from the 1st day of May, 1934.

REGULATIONS.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Milk Board Act 1933, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby make the following Regulations (that is to say):—

1. Contributions to Milk Board Fund.

Every dairyman and every owner of a dairy farm who sells or distributes milk by retail in the metropolis shall, from the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, contribute to the Milk Board Fund the sum of One-fourth of a penny per gallon for every gallon of milk so sold or distributed from time to time. Such contributions shall be paid to the Board within fourteen days after the end of each month.

2. Returns by Dairymen.

Every dairyman and every owner of a dairy farm who sells or distributes milk by retail in the metropolis shall, within fourteen days after the end of each month, furnish a return to the Board in the Form of Schedule I hereto.

3. Sale or Distribution by Retail Defined.

For the purpose of these Regulations, sale or distribution by retail shall include all sale or distribution of milk, excepting that which is sold or distributed to another dairyman.

4. Hours of Delivery.

The hours or times within which milk may be delivered by retail in the metropolis shall be as follow:—

Between the hours or times of Twelve o'clock midnight and Twelve o'clock midday on any day other than Sunday, and between the hours or times of Twelve o'clock midnight and Ten o'clock in the forenoon on Sundays.

This regulation shall not apply in respect to milk intended for sale or delivery to any hospital.

5. Milk Depots Prescribed.

The premises occupied by the persons or firms named hereunder, at the location stated, for the purpose of mixing or treating milk received direct from dairy farmers are hereby prescribed as "milk depots":—
