Factories and Shops Acts.

#### DETERMINATION OF THE WIREWORKERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 23rd April, 1935, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts, and the Order in Council thereunder, such portions of the City of Sandringham as are not included within the said Metropolitan District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warrnambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room in the process, trade, or business of—

A wire-worker, using six gauge or smaller wire: but not including persons employed in making wire netting, barbed wire, wire nails, or wire mattresses,"

has made the following Determination, viz.:-

(1) That on the 23rd April, 1935, the last prevous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
