# DETERMINATION OF THE CIGAR TRADE BOARD.

This Determination on the 1st May, 1935, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), and the Order in Council thereunder, and such portion of the city of Sandringham as is not included within the said District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warrnambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or 'rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of Cigar Making," has made the following Determination, viz.:---

(1) That on the 1st May, 1935, the last and all previous Determinations of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

<sup>(6)</sup> Warring Time.—When the hours of daily employment, as posted in the factory as required by the Factories and Shops Acts, are altered or departed from by the employer, and notice of such alteration or departure of at least 16 hours has not been given to all employees, such employees shall be paid for all time lost through such alteration or departure at the following rates, viz.:—Piece-workers, 2s. 6d. per hour; all other employees at ordinary rates.
