FURTHER PROROGUING THE PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Wednesday, the twentieth day of May, 1936 :
Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the twenty-third day of June, 1936.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this nineteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and in the first year of the reign of His Majesty King Edward VIII.
