## FURTHER PROROGUING THE PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands adjourned until Wednesday, the eighth day of April, 1936 :  
Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Wednesday, the twentieth day of May, 1936.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this seventh day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and in the first year of the reign of His Majesty King Edward VIII.
