Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935 (No. 4337).

DECLARING THAT CHICORY SHALL BECOME THE
PROPERTY OF THE CHICORY MARKETING BOARD.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,
&c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of section 16 of the
Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935 it is enacted
that when a product has been declared a commodity and a
Board has been appointed in relation thereto, the Governor
in Council may by Proclamation—

(a) provide and declare that the commodity shall forth-
with upon the date of publication of the Proclamation
be divested from the producers of the commodity
and become vested in and be the absolute property
of the Board as the owner thereof, and that upon
any of the commodity coming into existence within
a time specified in the same or a subsequent Pro-
clamation it shall by virtue of this Act become
vested in and be the absolute property of the
Board as the owner thereof; and

(b) make such further provisions as will enable the
Board effectively to obtain possession of the com-
modity as such owner and to deal with the same:

And whereas by a Proclamation made on the 24th day of
December, 1935, under the provisions of section 6 of the said
Act the Governor in Council declared chicory to be a commodity
under and for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas
by an Order made on the 7th April, 1936, the Governor in
Council appointed a Marketing Board in relation to chicory
and assigned to such Board the name of "The Chicory Market-
ing Board": Now therefore I, the Governor of the State
of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with
the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by
this my Proclamation hereby provide and declare that forth-
with upon the date of publication of this Proclamation in
the *Government Gazette* all chicory shall subject to and in
accordance with the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935*
be divested from the producers of chicory, and become vested
in and be the absolute property of The Chicory Marketing
Board as the owner thereof and that upon any chicory coming
into existence within two (2) years from the date of the

publication of this Proclamation as aforesaid they shall by
virtue of and subject to and in accordance with the said Act
become vested in and be the absolute property of The Chicory
Marketing Board as the owner thereof: And to enable The
Chicory Marketing Board as owners of the above-mentioned
commodity effectively to obtain possession thereof and to deal
with the same I do further provide that all such chicory shall
subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the said
Act be delivered by the producers thereof to The Chicory
Marketing Board or its authorized agent within such times
at such places and in such manner as The Chicory Marketing
Board by public notice, or in a particular case in writing,
directs or as are prescribed by Regulations made under the
said Act.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria
aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eighth day of April, in
the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and
thirty-six, and in the first year of the reign of His
Majesty King Edward VIII.

NOTICE TO PERSONS HOLDING STOCKS OF CHICORY.

IN pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred on me
by section 33 of the *Marketing of Primary Products Act*
1935 (No. 4337), I, Edmond John Hogan, Minister of Agri-
culture in the State of Victoria, do by this notice require all
persons in Victoria holding or having in their control on the
eighth day of April, 1936, more than one ton of chicory, to
furnish within seven days from the date of publication of
this notice in the *Government Gazette* to the Director of
Agriculture, Public Offices, Melbourne, a return setting forth
the quantity of chicory held by or under the control of any
of them on the eighth day of April, 1936.

APPOINTMENT OF CHICORY MARKETING BOARD.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation made on the 24th day of December, 1935, under the provisions of section 6 of the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935* (No. 4337) the Governor in Council declared chicory to be a commodity under and for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas by a Proclamation made on the 25th day of February, 1936, under section 6 of the said Act the Governor in Council declared that a Marketing Board shall be constituted in relation to the said commodity and that the provisions of the said Act shall apply to such commodity: And whereas it is provided by section 7 of the said Act that the Governor in Council after the application of the said Act to a commodity may by Order appoint a Marketing Board in relation to the commodity: And whereas it is further provided by the said section that the Board shall consist of the number of members specified in that behalf in a petition presented to the Governor in Council pursuant to section 6 of the said Act and of the members thereof one shall be a person appointed by the Governor in Council and the others shall be persons elected by the producers of the commodity in accordance with the said Act: And whereas it is provided by section 8 of the said Act that every Board constituted under the said Act shall be a body corporate by the name assigned to it by the Governor in Council: And whereas it is further provided by section 10 of the said Act that a person appointed or elected

as a member of a Board shall hold office for the period (not exceeding two years) for which he is appointed: And whereas the number of members specified in a petition presented to the Governor in Council pursuant to the said Act in relation to chicory was three: And whereas—

CHARLES HENRY EDWARDS and
RUPERT TREGONNING HARRIS

were elected by the producers of chicory as elective members of the Marketing Board constituted as aforesaid: Now therefore in pursuance of the powers conferred by the said Act and all other powers enabling him in that behalf His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council doth by this Order—

1. Appoint a Marketing Board in relation to chicory and assign to such Board the name of "The Chicory Marketing Board."
2. Appoint ALFRED HENRY JOHNSON as a member of The Chicory Marketing Board, to hold office for a period of two years.
3. Declare that The Chicory Marketing Board shall consist of three members, namely—
ALFRED HENRY JOHNSON,
CHARLES HENRY EDWARDS, and
RUPERT TREGONNING HARRIS.
4. Appoint the said—
CHARLES HENRY EDWARDS and
RUPERT TREGONNING HARRIS
to hold office as members of The Chicory Marketing Board for a period of two years.

And the Honorable Edmond John Hogan, His Majesty's Minister of Agriculture for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
