FURTHER PROROGUING PARLIAMENT AND FIXING THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE THIRD
SESSION OF THE THIRTY-SECOND PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of
Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the eighth day of June, 1937:
Now I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do
by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the sixth day of July,
1937, and I do hereby fix Tuesday, the sixth day of July, 1937, aforesaid, at the hour of Twelve o'clock noon,
as the time for the commencement and holding of the next Session of the said Parliament of Victoria, for the
despatch of business, in the Parliament Houses, situate in Spring-street, in the City of Melbourne: And the
Honorable the Members of the Legislative Council and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby
required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this seventh day
of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and in the first year
of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
