Wheat Products Prices Act (No. 4595).
FIXING THE MAXIMUM PRICE FOR BREAD.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by section 14 of the *Wheat Products Prices Act 1938* (No. 4595) it is provided that the Governor in Council may from time to time on the recommendation of the Wheat Products Prices Committee by Proclamation fix the maximum price at which any of the substances included in the interpretation of flour or in the interpretation of wheat products may be sold: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and on the recommendation of the Wheat Products Prices Committee, do by this my Proclamation hereby fix the maximum price at which a four (4) pound loaf of bread may be sold, delivered to the buyer within the following localities to be that set out hereunder: And I do further declare that this Proclamation shall come into force at 12.30 a.m. on Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of December, 1938.
