Dairy Products Acts.

QUOTAS FOR BUTTER AND CHEESE. BUTTER QUOTA.

I. E. J. HOGAN, Minister of Agriculture in the State of Victoria, after consultation with the Victorian Dairy Products Board, and after ascertaining that the supply and distribution of butter at reasonable prices to consumers thereof in Victoria will be ensured, hereby determine a quota for butter as follows:—

The proportion shall be 72 per cent.

The period for which this quota is to operate shall be the month of May, 1938.

#### CHEESE QUOTA.

I. J. HOGAN, Minister of Agriculture in the State of Victoria, after consultation with the Victorian Dairy Products Board, and after ascertaining that the supply and distribution of cheese at reasonable prices to consumers thereof in Victoria will be ensured, hereby determine a quota for cheese as follows:—

The proportion shall be 70 per cent.

The period for which this quota is to operate shall be the month of May, 1938.
