MILK BOARD ACTS 1933, 1934, 1936.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twentieth day of January, 1939.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor of Victoria. Mr. Old Mr. Hogan.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the Milk Board Acts 1933, 1934, 1936, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby approve the following Determination of milk prices by the Milk Board:—

DETERMINATION.

- 1. The minimum prices which shall be paid to owners of dairy farms for milk for sale or distribution in the metropolis shall be as follow:—
 - (a) By dairymen for-
 - (i) Untreated milk-ls. 34d. per gallon ex-rail; 1s. 4d. per gallon ex-road.
 - (ii) Treated milk—1s. 4½d. per 1s. 4½d. per gallon ex-road. gallon ex-rail;

Provided that when the purchaser provides the road transport throughout, he may deduct from the purchase price payable to the vendor such sum per gallon as shall be determined by the Milk Board in respect of such service.

- (b) By owners of milk depots
 - ls. 34d. per gallon at milk depot.

Provided that the owner of such milk depot may deduct from the determined price for milk forwarded either by road or rail to the metropolis, such sum per gallon as shall be determined by the Milk Board in respect of road or rail transport.

- 2. The minimum prices which shall be paid to owners of milk , depots for milk for sale or distribution in the metropolis
 - (a) For bottled milk-
 - By any person-1s. 9d. per gallon.
 - (b) For bulk milk-
 - (i) By dairymen, or by any person for use in the manufacture of biscuits, confectionery, ice cream, and milk blocks—Is. 44d. per gallon.
 (ii) By prescribed charitable institutions—Is. 4½d. per gallon.
 (iii) By any other person—Is. 6d. per gallon.
- 3. The minimum prices which shall be paid to dairymen (in the case of sales other than sales by retail) for milk for sale or distribution in the metropolis, shall be as follow:—
 - (a) For bottled milk-
 - By any person-1s. 9d. per gallon.
 - (b) For bulk milk-
 - (i) By any person for use in the manufacture of biscuits, confectionery, ice cream, and milk blocks—ls. 4½d. per gallon.
 (ii) By prescribed charitable institutions—ls. 4½d. per gallon.
 (iii) By any other person—ls. 6d. per gallon.
- 4. This Determination shall take effect from the twentyfirst day of January, 1939, and is substituted for the Determination made by Order in Council on the twenty-sixth day of April, 1938.
