APPOINTMENT OF ROYAL COMMISSION TO INQUIRE INTO BUSH FIRES WHICH BURNED IN VICTORIA IN JANUARY, 1939.

HIS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth, by an Order made on the twenty-seventh day of January, 1939, hereby appoint—

LEONARD EDWARD BISHOP STRETTON, a Judge of County Courts,

to be a Royal Commission to inquire into and report upon—

- (1) The causes and origins of the serious bush fires which burned in various parts of Victoria during the month of January, 1939;
- (2) the measures taken to prevent the outbreak and spread of such fires and the measures taken to protect life and private and public property;
- (3) the measures which are necessary or desirable to be taken by any and what persons, corporations, or bodies to prevent the outbreak of bush fires in Victoria, or to prevent the spreading of such fires; and
- (4) the measures which are necessary or desirable to be taken by any and what persons, corporations, or bodies to protect life and private and public property in the event of bush fires burning in Victoria.

QUOTAS FOR BUTTER AND CHEESE.

BUTTER QUOTA.

I. E. J. HOGAN, Minister of Agriculture in the State of Victoria, after consultation with the Victorian Dairy Products Board, and after ascertaining that the supply and distribution of butter at reasonable prices to consumers thereof in Victoria will be ensured, hereby determine a quota for butter as follows:—

The proportion shall be **Forty-three per cent.**

The period for which this quota is to operate shall be the month of February, 1939.

CHEESE QUOTA.

I. E. J. HOGAN, Minister of Agriculture in the State of Victoria, after consultation with the Victorian Dairy Products Board, and after ascertaining that the supply and distribution of cheese at reasonable prices to consumers thereof in Victoria will be ensured, hereby determine a quota for cheese as follows:—

The proportion shall be **Thirty-three and one-third per cent.**

The period for which this quota is to operate shall be the month of February, 1939.
