APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE EGG AND EGG
PULP MARKETING BOARD.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935*, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order—

- (1) appoint PERCIVAL GEORGE BARWELL as a Member of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board constituted under the said Act, to hold office for a period of two (2) years from and inclusive of the 10th February, 1939; and
- (2) appoint JAMES CARTER,
ARTHUR APLIN COLES,
HERBERT COTTON,
HARRY HOLLOWAY LLOYD,

as Members of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board for a period of two (2) years from and inclusive of the 10th February, 1939; such persons having been elected by the producers of eggs and egg pulp as elective members of such Board, pursuant to and in accordance with the said Act.

And the Honorable Edmond John Hogan, His Majesty's Minister of Agriculture for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
