## DETERMINATION OF THE COAL AND COKE BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board which now has power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in any business or occupation connected with the sale or distribution of coal or coke by any—

- (a) coal importer,
- (b) coalmine owner,
- (c) gas company,
- (d) agent or contractor who distributes coal or coke for any coal importer, coalmine owner, or gas company "has made the following Determination, namely:-
- (1) That on the 1st December, 1939, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this-Determination.
