REGULATIONS FOR THE CARE, PROTECTION, AND MANAGEMENT OF THE RESERVE FOR PUBLIC GARDENS KNOWN AS "LAKE RESERVE," AT STAWELL.

WHEREAS by the 181st section of the *Land Act 1928* power is given to the Board of Land and Works to make Rules and Regulations and to rescind any Rules and Regulations for the care, protection, and management of all public parks and reserves not conveyed to and vested in trustees, and for the preservation of good order and decency therein, and also for the collection and receipt of tolls, entrance fees, and other charges for entering therein or upon: Now therefore the Board of Land and Works, in pursuance of the powers conferred as aforesaid, doth hereby make the following Regulations in respect of the land temporarily reserved by Order in Council of 20th June, 1905, as a site for Public Gardens in the Municipal District of Stawell, in lieu of all previous Regulations, which are hereby rescinded.

REGULATIONS.

1. The Reserve shall be open to the public, free of charge, at all times except as hereinafter provided.

2. No person shall enter or remain in the Reserve who may offend against decency as regards dress, language, or conduct, and no society, club, picnic party, or other combined body shall be allowed to use the Reserve without the permission, in writing, of the Committee of Management.

3. No person shall climb or jump over the fence or gates, stick bills thereon, or cut names in the fences, trees, seats, or in any way damage any of the buildings, gates, fences, seats, or any property in or around the Reserve, or leave or roll stones therein, or pollute any water in the Reserve, or remove therefrom any soil, sand, or manure.

4. No person shall interfere with the trees, shrubs, or other property in the Reserve, or throw any stones or other missiles, or commit any nuisance, or leave therein any bottles or other litter.

5. No person shall erect any booth or other structure in the Reserve for the purpose of offering for sale any article, or hawk or offer for sale any goods or articles of any description without the permission, in writing, of the Committee of Management.

6. No person shall put in the Reserve any cattle, horses, sheep, goats, pigs, or any other animals, without the permission, in writing, of the Committee of Management being first obtained. The Committee of Management shall have full power and authority to impound any cattle found trespassing in the Reserve. For the purposes of this clause cattle shall mean cattle as interpreted by section 3 of the *Pounds Act 1928*.

7. No person shall bring into the Reserve any dog unless controlled by a chain or cord.

8. No person shall camp on any portion of the Reserve except in those parts specially set apart for the purpose by the Committee of Management, and then only after obtaining a permit, subject to such conditions and the payment of such fees as may be determined by the said Committee.

The fee payable to the Committee of Management for the right to camp in the portion of the Reserve set apart for the purpose shall be:—

For each day or portion of a day—One shilling (1s.).

For each week—Five shillings (5s.).

9. No fires shall be lighted in the Reserve except in the fire places which are provided for the purpose.

10. Camp sites while being occupied by a camp party must be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and all refuse, litter, and garbage produced at a camp or camp site must be collected and burnt before the camp party vacates the Reserve.

11. No person shall perform in any band of music or take part in any entertainment of any sort in the Reserve without permission, in writing, of the Committee of Management first obtained.

12. No person shall spit or expectorate on the paths, or on any structure or erection in the Reserve.

13. No person shall bet publicly in any part of the Reserve, and any person infringing this Regulation shall be liable to expulsion from the enclosure and Reserve.

14. No person shall play, practise, or engage in any game or sport within the Reserve on Sundays.

15. Persons renting or hiring any stand, building, or erection or enclosure on the occasions of any fêtes, sports, or holiday amusements may be required to deposit any sum which the Committee of Management may at any time determine, not exceeding Ten pounds (£10), by way of guarantee that due care shall be taken of such stand, building, erection, or enclosure, and such Committee of Management in its absolute discretion may make good any damage or injury sustained by such stand, building, erection, or enclosure, or anything contained therein, during such occupancy or hiring, and deduct the cost of making good such loss or damage from the sum of

money deposited by way of guarantee, and all persons so renting or hiring shall abide by these Regulations and by any order given by the Committee of Management.

16. No persons, except labourers and workmen employed in the Reserve, shall enter any plots therein which may be enclosed for plantation of young shrubs or trees.

The Reserve has been placed under the control of the Council of the Borough of Stawell in the capacity of a Committee of Management, with power and authority to impose the foregoing Regulations.

Every person offending against these Regulations shall, in accordance with the provisions of section 181 of the *Land Act 1928*, for each offence be liable to a penalty of not more than Five pounds (£5), and every person who knowingly and wilfully offends against any such Regulations, and who, after he has been warned by any bailiff of Crown lands or by any member of the Police Force, does not desist from so offending, may be forthwith apprehended by such bailiff or member of the Police Force and taken before some justice to be dealt with according to law, and shall be liable to a penalty of not more than Ten pounds (£10).
