## FURTHER PROROGUING THE PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the eleventh day of March, 1941:  
Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the sixth day of May, 1941.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this tenth day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-one, and in the fifth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
