STATE OF VICTORIA.

AIR RAID WARNING SYSTEM ORDER.

WHEREAS pursuant to Order No. 27 made under the provisions of the National Security (General) Regulations of the Commonwealth the Chief Commissioner of Police may specify by notice published in the *Victoria Government Gazette* such other vehicles than those specified in Clause 6n of such Order as to which the provisions of Clause 6A of the said Order shall not apply:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the said Order, I, Alexander Mitchell Duncan, Chief Commissioner of Police, do hereby specify the following vehicles to which the provisions of the aforesaid Clause 6A shall not apply:—

- (a) Vehicles approved by the Chief Commissioner of Police for use for maintenance and repair of—
Water Supply and Sewerage Systems,
Harbor, Port or Marine Establishments,
Gas Undertakings,
Electrical Undertakings,
Victorian Railways.
- (b) Vehicles approved by the Chief Commissioner of Police for use by the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board and Victorian Railways Departments, in connexion with the maintenance and repair of the Tramway systems under their respective control.
- (c) Vehicles approved by the Chief Commissioner of Police for use by the Victorian Bush Fire Brigades Association and the Forests Commission of Victoria for fire-fighting purposes.
