REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE SAWING OF FIREWOOD.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the National Security (Emergency Powers) Acts, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth make the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Security (Fire-wood Saws) Regulations (No. 2). Citation.

2. The National Security (Firewood Saws) Regulations are amended by adding at the end of clause 2 thereof the following clause:—

“3. (1) Any person aggrieved by the action of the council of any municipality in granting, or refusing or failing to grant, or specifying terms and conditions in, a permit under the last preceding clause may, after giving notice in writing to the council of his intention so to do, appeal to the Minister of Water Supply. Appeal to Minister against grant or refusal of permit.

(2) Upon such appeal the Minister may direct that—

- (a) any permit so granted shall be withdrawn or varied;
- or
- (b) any permit which such council has failed or refused to grant shall be granted subject to such terms and conditions as the Minister specifies—

and thereupon such permit shall be withdrawn varied or granted by the municipal clerk for and on behalf of such council accordingly.”

And the Honorable Albert Arthur Dunstan, His Majesty's Premier for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
