COMMONWEALTH NATIONAL SECURITY (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.

STATE OF VICTORIA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by clause 7 of the Lighting Restriction Order (Victoria) made under the provisions of Regulation 35. of the Commonwealth National Security (General) Regulations, I, Albert Arthur Dunstan, Premier of the State of Victoria, hereby direct that on the 21st day of February, 1942, between the hours of 9.30 p.m. and 10.30 p.m. throughout the area lying within a radius of five miles of the Post Office at Wangaratta—

- (a) No person shall cause or allow any artificial light to be emitted from any enclosed building,
- (b) The second signal shall be deemed to sound at 9.30 p.m. and the third signal at 10.30 p.m.
