ELECTION OF A MEMBER OF THE NURSES BOARD.

IN pursuance of paragraph (c) of sub-section (2) of section 2 of the *Nurses Act 1940* (being an amendment of the *Nurses Acts*), an election of a *Midwife* (not being a registered Nurse) as the representative of registered Midwives (who are not registered Nurses) to the Nurses Board will be held on Friday, the twenty-fifth (25th) day of February, 1944.

The Returning Officer appointed for such election is William Leslie Rowe, Chief Electoral Officer for the State of Victoria, and his address is Old Treasury Buildings, Spring-street, Melbourne.

Nominations are invited from such Midwives whose names appear on the Midwives Register, and nomination forms may be obtained from the Returning Officer.

Any nomination of a person for election as a representative of registered Midwives on the said Board shall be lodged with the Returning Officer not later than twelve o'clock noon on the nomination day, Friday, the fourth (4th) day of February, 1944.
