DAY OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the *Ministry of Health Act 1943* (No. 4988) it is provided that the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation:

Now therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday, the fourteenth day of February, 1944, as the day on which the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fourteenth day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, and in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
