FURTHER PROROGUING THE PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the fourteenth day of March, 1944: Now I, the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the eleventh day of April, 1944.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eleventh day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, and in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
