DISCHARGED SERVICEMEN'S PREFERENCE ACT 1943.

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION OF ACT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI. intitled the *Discharged Servicemen's Preference Act 1943* (No. 4989) it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*: Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the 21st day of March, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, as the day on which the said *Discharged Servicemen's Preference Act 1943* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-first day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, and in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
