That the abovementioned Determination be amended by deleting therefrom clause (6) ("Special Rates"), and substituting therefor the following clause, namely:—

"6. SPECIAL RATES.—For all work done on Sundays and the undermentioned holidays the rates shall be:—

Sundays	}	Burners, time and a half.
	}	All others, double time.

New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day	}	All persons, double time;
---	---	---------------------------

but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted."
