*Vegetation and Vine Diseases Act 1928.*

APPOINTMENT OF INSPECTORS.

I, THE undersigned, Norman Angus Martin, being the responsible Minister of the Crown for the time being administering the *Vegetation and Vine Diseases Act 1928*, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me under the provisions of section 9 of the said Act, do hereby appoint the under-mentioned persons to exercise with respect to any land whatsoever in that part of Victoria which lies within the limits of the Central Bailiwick of the Supreme Court of Victoria as defined in the Third Schedule to the *Supreme Court Act 1928*, the following powers, that is to say, to enter upon such land whatsoever at any time with or without assistants to search for diseased trees, plants, or vegetables, and to remain thereon so long as may be reasonable for such purpose:—

## Vegetation and Vine Diseases Act 1928.

## APPOINTMENT OF INSPECTORS.

## CITY OF OAKLEIGH.

BY-LAW No. 67.

A By-law of the City of Oakleigh, made under the provisions of the Local Government Acts, and numbered 67, for the purpose of requiring the removal of undergrowth, weeds, or grass from land in cases where, in the opinion of the Council, such undergrowth, weeds, or grass constitutes a fire menace to neighbouring property, and enabling the Council, in the event of default by the owner or occupier, to remove the same, and to recover the cost thereof from the owner or occupier.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the Local Government Acts and of any and every other power it thereunto enabling, the Council of the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Oakleigh orders as follows:—

1. In cases where, in the opinion of the Council, any undergrowth, weeds, or grass on land within the district of the municipality of the City of Oakleigh (the whole of which district is hereby declared to be a populous or residential area) constitutes a fire menace to neighbouring property, the Council is hereby authorized and empowered to require the removal of such undergrowth, weeds, or grass from the said land.

2. (a) The Council shall cause a notice, duly signed by the Town Clerk, to be served on either the owner or the occupier, as the Council shall decide, requiring such owner or occupier

(as the case may be) to remove such undergrowth, weeds, or grass from the said land within a time to be set forth in such notice.

(b) In the event of default by the owner or occupier (as the case may be) the Council is hereby authorized to remove the said undergrowth, weeds, or grass from the said land, and to recover the cost thereof from such owner or occupier (as the case may be).
