REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE SAWING OF FIREWOOD.

I N pursuance of the powers conferred by the National Security (Emergency Powers) Acts, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth make the following Regulations, that is to say:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Security (Fire-Citation. wood Saws) Regulations (No. 3).
- 2. In sub-clause (1) of clause 3 of the National Security (Firewood Amendment Saws) Regulations for the words "of Water Supply" there shall be of National Security substituted the words "appointed for the time being by the Premier (Firewood Saws) Regulations." to administer these Regulations".

REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE RATIONING OF FUEL.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the National Security (Emergency Powers) Acts, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth make the following Regulations, that is to say:—

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Security (Fuel Rationing) Regulations (No. 4).

Amendment of National Security (Fuel Rationing) Regulations. "Minister."

- 2. The National Security (Fuel Rationing) Regulations are amended—
 - (a) by substituting for the words "for Water Supply" in the definition of "Minister" in clause 2 the words "appointed for the time being by the Premier to administer these Regulations";

Maximum delivery of fuel.

- (b) by substituting for paragraphs (b) and (c) of sub-clause (1) of clause 5 the following paragraph:—
 - "(b) more than five hundredweights of fuel at any one time.";
- (c) by substituting for the words "three hundredweights of fuel at any one time during the winter months and more than five hundredweights of fuel at any one time during the summer months" in paragraph (a) of sub-clause (3) of clause 5 the words "five hundredweights of fuel at any one time"; and

Monthly statements by suppliers.

- (d) by substituting for sub-clause (5) of clause 8 the following sub-clause:—
 - "(5) Every supplier shall furnish to the Minister within three days after the end of each month a statement of the amount of fuel which he has received and sold in that month."

And the Honorable Albert Arthur Dunstan, His Majesty's Premier of the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
