ORDERS REVOCATION ORDER.

ORDER No. 62.

WHEREAS by Regulation 35A of the Commonwealth National Security (General) Regulations it is provided, inter alia, that the Premier of any State may, after consultation with the Minister of State for Home Security or an officer of the Department of Home Security authorized by that Minister to act on his behalf and with the Commander of a Lines of Communication Area or an officer authorized by the Minister of State for the Army to act on behalf of such Commander, by Order make such provision as he deems necessary to protect the persons and property of the civil population in that State or any part thereof in case of emergency :-

Now therefore I, Ian Macfarlan, Premier of the State of Victoria, having duly held such consultations, do hereby make the following Order:-
