FIXING THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE FIRST SESSION OF THE THIRTY-SIXTH PARLIAMENT  
OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth  
of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation  
fix Wednesday, the twenty-eighth day of November, 1945, as the time for the commencement and holding of the  
First Session of the Thirty-sixth Parliament of Victoria, for the despatch of business, at the hour of Eleven  
o'clock in the forenoon, in the Parliament Houses, situate in Spring-street, in the City of Melbourne: And the  
Honorable the Members of the Legislative Council and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby  
required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-third  
day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, and in the ninth  
year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
