EXTENSION OF METROPOLIS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the *Milk Board Act 1933* and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do by this my Proclamation declare the municipal district of the Shire of Lillydale and the municipal district of the Shire of Werribee to be included in the "Metropolis," such Proclamation to have effect on and from the first day of March, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-eighth day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, and in the ninth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
