### DETERMINATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT.

IN THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT:

IN THE MATTER of a Determination of the Shops Board No. 13 (Fuel and Fodder-Country) made on the 24th August, 1944,

AND

IN THE MATTER of an Appeal against certain provisions of the said Determination.

(Before His Honour Judge Stretton, Mr. C. H. Grant, and Mr. J. V. Stout.)

Wednesday, the 20th day of December, 1944.

Having heard the abovementioned Appeal this Court doth determine that such Appeal be allowed, and doth order that, for Clause (16) of the said Determination, there shall be substituted the following clause:—

#### PIECE-WORK.

"(16).--A schedule of piece-work prices to be paid to any person for doing certain kinds of work has been fixed by the Board.
