NOTICE pursuant to LIQUOR CONTROL ORDER (VICTORIA) No. 9,
made under the Commonwealth National Security (Supplementary)
Regulations.

TAKE NOTICE that for the period from 10 a.m. o'clock on Wednesday,
the 9th day of May, 1945, until 10 a.m. o'clock on Thursday, the
10th day of May, 1945—

- (a) a person shall not on or from any licensed premises or the premises of any registered club sell, dispose of or supply any liquor to any person;
- (b) a person shall not purchase obtain or consume liquor on or from any licensed premises or the premises of any registered club;
- (c) a licensee shall not permit any door of, or opening into, any bar-room on his licensed premises to be open or unlocked.
