WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the tenth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI. initituled the Public Service Act 1946 (No. 5124) it is amongst other things enacted by section 1 thereof that Part I. of the Act (and so much of section 3 as is applicable) should come into operation on a day to be appointed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette and that save as otherwise expressly provided the remainder of the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette: And whereas by a proclamation made on the 13th August, 1946, and published in the Government Gazette on the 14th August, 1946, as the day upon which the said Part I. (and so much of the said section 3 as is applicable) should come into operation: Now therefore, I. the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my Proclamation fix the 20th day of October. 1946. as the day upon which the said remainder of the Public Service Act 1946 shall come into operation.
