Public Service Act 1946.

REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1946*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as follows:—

Sub-regulation (3) of Regulation 48A is hereby revoked and the following sub-regulation inserted in lieu thereof:—

“(3) The annual amount or range of salary assigned to each office classified in Class “A1” or Class “A” of the Administrative Division shall be that entered opposite the name thereof in the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations. The occupant of each such office on the 1st. February, 1947, shall be paid the appropriate sum specified in the last column of such Schedule.”

TEACHING SERVICE ACT 1946.

REGULATIONS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Teaching Service Act* 1946, the Teachers Tribunal hereby makes the following Regulations:—

PRELIMINARY.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Teaching Service (Classification, Salaries and Allowances) Regulations" and shall come into operation on 29th December, 1946.

2. These Regulations are divided into parts as follows:—

- PART I.—Primary Schools Division.
- PART II.—Secondary Schools Division.
- PART III.—Technical Schools Division.
- PART IV.—General Provisions.
- PART V.—Professional Officers.
- PART VI.—Student Teachers.
- PART VII.—Sewing Mistresses.
- PART VIII.—Instructors in Reconstruction Training.
- PART IX.—Allowances.

PART IV.—GENERAL PROVISIONS.

Relating to Primary Schools, Secondary Schools and Technical Schools Divisions.

15. A student who satisfactorily completes a course of training at a Teachers' College or other prescribed institution shall be placed in the subdivision of the lowest class in which he would have been entitled to be placed if his period of training had been service as a classified teacher and he had received sub-divisional promotion by the appropriate Committee of Classifiers. For the purpose of this clause any completed year of an approved University course prior to appointment shall be regarded as a year of training.

16. A teacher shall be eligible for promotion by the appropriate Committee of Classifiers from one subdivision of a class to a higher sub-division therein after one year's service therein.

17. A teacher who fails to obtain sub-divisional promotion in any year may be promoted by the appropriate Committee of Classifiers in any subsequent year to the subdivision to which he would have been promoted if no such failure had occurred.

18. A teacher who immediately prior to the commencement of these Regulations was classified in the fifth class and on account of the revision of salaries prescribed in the Public Service Revision of Salaries dated 22nd September, 1941, or the Budget of 1943-44 was in receipt of a total salary within the range of salaries of the then existing fourth class shall, for salary purposes only, be deemed to be classified in the subdivision of the fourth class corresponding with his salary, shall have his salary adjusted in accordance with the table of adjustment set out in these Regulations, and shall be entitled to proceed by annual sub-divisional increments to the maximum salary of the fourth class.
