MOTOR OMNIBUS ACT 1928 (No. 3742).

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the second day of April, 1946.

GENERAL RE-PRESCRIPTION AS FROM 1st APRIL, 1946, AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. OF ROUTES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN AREA ALONG WHICH MOTOR OMNIBUSES MAY PLY FOR HIRE.

HIS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Motor Omnibus Act 1928 (No. 3742), doth by this Order prescribe in Schedules of the consent of the motor omnibuses for which "regular service" licences are granted may ply for hire, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 19 of the said Act, doth consent to the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board continuing to use until further notice, motor omnibuses to ply for hire within the metropolitan area along the routes described in Schedule (3) hereunder: also doth prescribe sections, terminal points and stopping places, time-tables to be observed by operators (including the said Board) of motor omnibuses plying for hire, fares to be charged, and the maximum number of motor omnibuses which may be licensed to ply for hire, or may be operated by the said Board to ply for hire, on such routes, as set forth in detail in the said three Schedules.

DEVELOPMENTAL ROUTES.

His Excellency, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 5 of the said Act, doth by this Order prescribe Routes Nos. 5A, 6A, 7A, 8A, 9A, 13A, 15A, 16A, 17A, 20A, 25A, 26A, 30A, 31A, 32A, 34A, 36A, 38A, 39A, 43A, 44A, 46A, 47A, 48A, 53A, 56A, 57A, 60A, 63A, 64A, 67A, 71A, 74A, 75A, 77A, 78A, 80A, 82A, 83A, 87A, 90A, 92A, 96A, 100A, 102A, 105A, 111A, and 112A as described in Schedule (2) hereunder, as Developmental Routes.

GENERAL CONDITIONS.

His Excellency, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 4, section 15, and section 19, of the said Act, doth further prescribe the following general conditions in respect of metropolitan motor omnibus routes hereunder prescribed, or which at any time hereafter are prescribed under the provisions of the said Act, viz:—

Week Days and Saturdays .- Except where otherwise indicated, the expression "week days" shall be deemed to include Saturdays.

Sections.—The term "Section" shall be deemed also to mean any part of the section, and the term "Sections" shall be deemed also to mean any part of any such sections.

Stopping Places.—For the purpose of taking up and/or setting down passengers on routes, motor omnibuses shall, in addition to stopping at such places as are specifically prescribed, also stop at such other places as may be convenient, and in all instances in such manner as not to interfere with or endanger the general traffic of the streets or roads or the safety of passengers in the motor omnibuses. Fares to be Charged.—The fares shown under the heading "Fares to be Charged" shall be the fares to be charged for each adult.

Except where and as otherwise prescribed herein, the fares to be charged for children under twelve years of age (other than children under three years of age carried on passenger's lap, who shall be carried free) shall be one-half of the fares charged for adult passengers, and such half fares shall be calculated to the nearest higher penny for children carried on motor omnibuses operated other than by the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board, and to the nearest lower penny for children carried on motor omnibuses operated by the said Board.

Time tables.—The minimum service prescribed under the heading "Time tables to be observed" shall be deemed to mean the minimum service to be provided in the form of separate and distinct complete trips from either terminal of a route to the other terminal of the route.

Except where and as otherwise prescribed herein, however, operators, including the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board, may operate such additional trips as they deem to be required, including shorter trips not necessarily including either of the normal terminals of the route, but except where, and as otherwise prescribed herein, no motor-omnibus may be plied for hire during the period between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m. on week days, and between 1 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Sundays.

Provided, however, that motor omnibuses operated for hire on the above-mentioned routes between North Fitzroy and Maribyrnong and Footscray and Coburg—North Essendon and Maribyrnong and Footscray, shall ply for hire for the conveyance of employees of the Munition Factories, Maribyrnong and Footscray only, and to and from the said Munition Factories only:

Provided further that the said routes shall be deemed to have been authorized for the specific purpose of coping with emergency transport conditions which have arisen in connexion with the conveyance of employees engaged in or associated with the manufacture of munitions of war, and that accordingly the said routes shall continue to be operated for so long only as the Governor in Council considers that such emergency conditions continue to exist.

Authority to Carry Order into Effect.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 15 (1) (c) of the Motor Omnibus Act 1928, No. 3742, His Excellency doth by this Order confer upon the Licensing Authority full power and authority for carrying into effect by the said Licensing Authority of the foregoing provisions of this order in respect of the routes prescribed in Schedules (1) and (2).

And the Honorable Patrick John Kennelly, His Majosty's Commissioner of Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
