Public Service Act 1946.

REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND
ALLOWANCES.

EMPLOYEES.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Public Service Act, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as follows :—

Regulation 62 is hereby revoked and the following Regulation inserted in lieu thereof :—

“ 62 (1). The annual amount or range of salary payable to persons employed temporarily in the Public Service shall be that entered opposite the respective designations of the positions occupied by such persons in the Fifth and Sixth Schedules to these Regulations.

Provided that, where any such person was eligible, immediately prior to this Regulation, to proceed to any higher rate of pay in accordance with an approved scale of payment, he shall continue to be so eligible.

(2). The provisions of sub-regulation 2 of Regulation 50 and of Regulations 51, 52, 55, 57, 58, and 59 shall be deemed to be incorporated in this Regulation *mutatis mutandis*.”

After the Fourth Schedule to the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations the following new Schedule is inserted :—
