- (1) That the aforesaid Determination of the Cigar Trade Board be amended in the following manner, namely:—

Each piecework price (exclusive of extras and additional amounts) specified in Clause (12) sub-clauses (a), (b), (c), and (d) shall be reduced by the sum of 1½d.

- (2) That this Determination of the Industrial Appeals Court shall be operative on and after the 16th day of April, 1947.
