PROROGUING THE PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands adjourned until such day and hour as may be fixed by the President of the Legislative Council and by the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly respectively: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the second day of September, 1947.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fifth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, and in the eleventh year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
