Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Apprentices.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 115s, per week.

An indenture of apprenticeship prescribed was approved on 13th March, 1914.

Improvers.

One improver to every four workers receiving not less than 152s, per week,

Juvenile Workers, i.e., persons under 21 years of age (other than apprentices or improvers) cleaning, cutting out blanks, dipping, numbering, saw plercing, polishing, sand blasting, waxing, pinning up, soldering, or press working.
