## DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1948.

### GENERAL BOARD.

(Abrasives Section.)

Clause 2 of the Determination for this Section made on the 13th November, 1947, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after the 1st January, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

and thereafter the minimum wage.

**NOTE.**—The rates prescribed for improvers shall apply only to such employees as are under 21 years of age, or who being over 21 years of age, are the holders of improvers' licences.

**PROPORTION.**

(a) *Abrasive Paper or Cloth.*

One improver to each person of the same sex receiving not less than the minimum wage.

(b) *Abrasive Articles (other than Abrasive Paper or Cloth).*

Two improvers to the first adult employed, and thereafter one improver to each adult.

Clauses other than clause 2 of the said Determination for this Section shall remain in force.
