DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

APPRENTICES.

Feather Duster or Mop Sections.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 126a. per week of 40 hours.

Feather Duster Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 126s, per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 83s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

IMPROVERS.

Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 126s. per week of 40

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 83s. 3d. per Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 126s, per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.
