DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Clause 2 of the Determination made on the 26th November, 1947, and in force from the 1st January, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clause:—
