Upon appeals made on the 1st and 6th days of March, 1948, and this day by (a) The Victorian Chamber of Manufactures, The Victorian Employers Federation, and the Melbourne Chamber of Commerce being Associations of Employers concerned in the said Determination, and (b) by all the representatives of the employees on the said Board against the Determination of the Commercial Clerks Board dated the 29th day of January, 1948, AND UPON READING the notices of appeal dated the 3rd day of February, 1948, and the 29th day of January, 1948, respectively, AND UPON HEARING Mr. A. J. Aird for and on behalf of the aforementioned Associations of Employers, and Mr. E. A. H. Laurie for and on behalf of the representatives of the employees on the Commercial Clerks Board, THIS COURT DOTH DETERMINE:—

- (a) That both Appeals be dismissed.
- (b) That the Determination operate from the date prescribed by the Wages Board, namely the 13th February, 1948.
