**DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE
FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).**

Clause 2 of the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 453 of the 24th November 1947, shall be replaced by the following clause:—
