Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1948.

PORT PHILLIP SEAMEN'S BOARD.

A Diver's Assistant shall be paid, whilst engaged as such, at the rate prescribed for an A.B. plus an allowance at the rate of £1 per week.

(b) Shift Workers.—A shift worker, irrespective of the shift on which he may be employed, shall be paid the appropriate rate prescribed in sub-clause (a) hereof plus 6 per cent. calculated to the nearest shilling. For the purposes of this Part of the Determination a shift worker shall be deemed to be an employee who is ordinarily required to commence work before 7.25 a.m., or to finish after 4.25 p.m.

Clauses other than clauses 1 of Part I, 1 of Part II, and 1 of Part III of the said Determination shall remain in force.
