Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1948.

DENTAL MECHANICS BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination made on the 16th January, 1948, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

APPRENTICES.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

An amended indenture of apprenticeship prescribed was approved on 3rd September, 1925.

IMPROVERS.
(Dentists' Attendants.)

One improver to every ten or fraction of ten workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
