DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

PEMALES.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 100s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.

MALES.

Two male improvers to every male worker receiving not less than 132s, per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

Four female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than $100s.\ 9d.\ per$ week of 40 hours.
